INVITING COMMENTS ON THE PROPOSED AMENDMENTS IN
THE BSF HEADQUARTERS GROUP 'A' & GROUP 'B' POSTS
(NON COMBATISED) RECRUITMENT RULES -2013

Border Security Force propose to amend the Border Security Force Headquarters Group 'A' & Group 'B' posts (Non Combatised) Recruitment Rules-2013 for the posts Senior Administrative Officer having the Grade Pay of Rs.4600/- (Administrative Officer or Section officers with seven years regular service in the pay band of Rs.9300-34800) and (Administrative Officer or Section Officer with 10 years combined service in the grade pay of Rs.4200/- & 4600/-). Accordingly, the proposed Border Security Force Headquarters Group 'A' & Group 'B' posts (Non combatised) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules – 2016 have been prepared and required to be circulated.

In terms of DoP&T OM No.AB-14017/61/2008-Estt(RR) dated 13 Oct 2015, draft amendments have been uploaded to the **website of BSF and on IPP** , for comments from all stakeholders on the proposed Notification of BSF, Force Headquarters Group 'A' and Group 'B'; posts (Non Combatised) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2016 in the following format:-

Notification

New Delhi, the ___ 2016

G. S. R _____. - In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Border Security Force Headquarters Group 'A' and Group 'B' Posts (Non-combatised) in the Directorate General, Border Security Force Headquarters, 2013 namely:-

1. (1) These rules may be called the Border Security Force Headquarters Group 'A' and Group 'B' Posts (Non-combatised) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2016.
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. In the Border Security Force Headquarters Group 'A' and Group 'B' Posts (Non-combatised) Recruitment Rules, 2013, in the Schedule,-

- (2) against serial number 1, relating to the post of Senior Administrative Officer,-
under column 11, the following entries shall be substitute under heading, namely :-

“Promotion:

Administrative Officer or Section Officer with seven years regular service in the pay band of Rs.9300-34800 with grade pay of Rs.4600/- and who have successfully completed pre-promotional Course or courses as specified by the Director General, Border Security Force, from time to time;

or

Administrative officer or Section Officer with 10 years combined service in the GP of Rs.4200 and Rs.4600 and who have successfully completed the pre-promotion course or courses as may be specified by the DG BSF from time to time.

Note-1: Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their Juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.

Note-2: For the purpose of computing minimum qualifying service for promotion, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1st January 2006 or the date from which the revised pay structure based on the 6th Central Pay Commission recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay or pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the Commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade pay or pay scale, and where this benefit will extend only for the post(s) for which that grade pay or pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any up gradation.
