Subject: RELEGATION POLICY FOR ASSISTANT COMMANDANT (GD/LDCE) AND SUB-INSPECTOR (GD/LDCE) IN THE CENTRAL ARMED POLICE FORCES (CAPFs)

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AC (LDCE) and SI(LDCE) are based on the schemes circulated by the MHA vide their letter No. I-45022/83/2000 dated 21-08-2000 and No. I-45023/2/2009-Pers.II dated 16-04-2010.

2. The duration of training is of 24 weeks and at the end of said separate training, Asstt Comdts/Sub Insps (GD) selected through Limited Departmental Competitive Examination (LDCE) will be put through a test/examination to be conducted at respective training institute/Academy.

3. A trainee has to score the required percentage of marks in the subject(s) as prescribed by the concerned CAPFs to qualify the basic training.

4. If a trainee fails in any of the subject(s) in final term tests, he will be re-examined in the subject(s) in which he has failed. If the trainee is unable to pass in any subject(s) before the time of passing out of his batch, he will be relegated for a period of three months.

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5. The relegated trainee will remain in the Academy/Training Institute. He will be given training in the subject(s) in which he has failed to qualify. He will be re-tested in Academy in the subject(s) he has failed after a duration of three months.

6. If a trainee obtains the required marks in the re-test held after three months, he will be declared as having qualified the Basic training otherwise, he will be relegated for another period of three months.

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7. The trainee relegated for next three months will be given training in the Academy/Training Institutes in the subject(s) in which he has failed to qualify. He will be re-tested in the subject(s) he has failed after a duration of three months.

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8. If a trainee fails to qualify even after the second relegation of three months, he will be treated as 'failed' in his basic training and shall be reverted to his previous rank he was holding prior to his selection as Assistant Commandant/Sub Inspector (GD), through LDCE which is in consonance with the policy on the subject circulated vide MHA OM No.60/37/63 - Estt.(A), dated 14-07-1967 and 28015/2/80-Estt.(C) dated 22-07-1980 vide which he retain his lien in his parent department /office for a period of two years.

9. In case a trainee absents from training for a period of 10% of the total training period (training period will include working days + Sundays +GH) whether at stretch or accumulated, due to sickness, injury or leave, he will not be permitted to appear in the final test or Passing out Parade, and will be relegated for a period of three months. However, in case such absence is due to Over Staying from Leave/ Absent without Leave, Director Academy/Training Institute at his discretion may take action in accordance with prevalent Rules.

10. Relegated trainee(s) will continue to attend the complete duration of training as and when he becomes fit/on returning from leave, (before the period of relegation begins), his final test will be taken after the relegation period.

11. In any case, if a trainee is missing for a period of 10% of training (working days + Sundays + Gazetted Holidays),for reasons not covered in para-9, he will be relegated to the next batch, his training would be discontinued and he will remain at Academy, to join with the next batch as a fresh trainee. So long a trainee remains relegated or is unable to clear the final test, he will not wear the ranks of AC/SI.

12. If a trainee could not appear only in the final examination due to sickness/injury with period of absence being less than 10% of the total training and the trainee has undergone rest of the training successfully, then his/her performance of periodical test/midterm test will be considered. If performance is graded V.Good or above, then the trainee will be declared qualified and awarded with minimum passing marks.

13. Inter- se-seniority.-

(a) Inter-se-seniority of AC(GD/LDCE) & SI(GD/LDCE) shall be arranged in the order of merit which shall be determined after adding together the marks obtained by them in the Limited Department Competitive Examination conducted by the CAPF's, and the Basic Professional Course held at respective Training Institution as prescribed in the relevant Recruitment Rules.
