India's First Line of Defence, The Border Security Force (BSF) which has been safeguarding the India-Pakistan and India-Bangladesh borders since 1965 inducted two new advanced Mi – 17 V5 helicopters which will enhance the strength of BSF's Air Wing. The Air Wing is tasked to carry air support missions for BSF troops along the borders and in India's hinterland during Anti-Naxal operations.

The helicopters were inducted and bought into service by The Hon'ble Union Minister of State for Home Affairs Shri Kiren Rijiju on April 09th, 2015 at 1500 Hrs at Safdarjung Airport, BSF Air Wing, Hanger No-1, New Delhi. During the ceremony, Shri D K Pathak, IPS, Director General Border Security Force and senior officials of BSF were also present.
