**ADVERTISEMENT**

Applications are invited from Indian citizens (Male & Female) for filling up the vacancies of Veterinary Assistant Surgeon (Assistant Commandant) Group-A, Gazetted (Combatised) (Non-Ministerial) in Border Security Force, Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India. The post is temporary but likely to continue. Selected candidates shall be liable to serve anywhere in India or outside the territory of India and will be governed under BSF Act and Rules applicable to other members of the Force as the case may be. On appointment they shall be entitled for the pension benefits as per the "New Restructured Defined Contributory Pension Scheme" applicable for the new entrants to the Central Government Services w.e.f. 01-01-2004.

2. **Vacancies:** Total vacancies are 28 as per details given below:-

- Note:** 1. Vacancies are subject to change.  
2. Selected candidates are liable to be posted anywhere in the country according to transfer policy of the Force.  
3. The recruitment will be conducted on All India basis.

3. **PAY:** Rs.15600-39100 + Grade Pay Rs.5400/- (pre revised) per month plus other benefits like Dearness Allowances, House Rent Allowance, Transport Allowance, Non Practicing Allowance (NPA) at the rates prescribed by the Government from time to time.

4. **AGE:** Male and female candidates between 23 to 30 years of age.

**Note:** The crucial date for determining the upper age limit shall be the last date of receipt of applications from candidates of normal areas. The candidates must fulfill all eligibility conditions and should be in possession of all certificates as on the last date of receipt of applications.

**Relaxation:**

Relaxation in upper age limit for recruitment of Veterinary Assistant Surgeon (Assistant Commandant) shall be as under:-

- (a) Upto a maximum of 05 years if a candidate belongs to Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe.
- (b) Upto a maximum of 03 years if a candidate belongs to Other Backward Class (OBC).

- (c) The upper age limit of 05 years is relaxable in case of candidates already in Govt service. Govt employees/servants claiming age relaxation should be in possession of certificate in prescribed format from their office in respect of the length of continuous service which should not be less than 03 years in immediate period preceding the closing date of receipt of application from candidates of normal areas. They should continue to have the status of Govt servant/employee till the time of appointment, in the event of their selection. The candidate will have to produce NOC from his/her parent department at the time of applying for the post/recruitment in BSF.
- (d) The Relaxation in upper age limit of 5 years shall also be admissible to the candidates who had ordinarily been domiciled in the state of J&K during the peirod from 01-01-1980 to 31-12-1989. The candidate will have to produce a certificate from the concerned District Collector to claim such relaxation in age.
- (e) 5 years of age relaxation will also be granted to the children and dependent family members of those killed in the 1984 riots and 2002 communal riots of Gujarat.

**Children means** (a) Son (including adopted son) or (b) Daughter (including adopted daughter). **Dependent family members means:** (a) Spouse or (b) Children or Brother or Sister in the case of unmarried Govt servant who was wholly dependent on the Govt servant at the time of his killing in the riot. The candidate will have to produce a certificate to the effect, issued by the concerned District Collector to claim relaxation in age. Children and dependent family members of those killed in the riots (1984 riots 2002 communal riots of Gujarat) will also produce a certificate from the concerned District Collector.

- (f) The above relaxation in age as mentioned in Para-4 (c) to (e) is in addition to relaxation of 3 years for OBC & 05 years for SC/ST candidates as per Govt orders.

**Note:** Candidates claiming benefits under OBC, SC & ST category shall be in possession of certificate in accordance with Caste notified in the Central List. The certificate should be in the prescribed format issued by the Competent Authority empowered for the purpose. No other certificate will be accepted as proof.

5. **EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION/PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATION:**

The candidate must be in possession of a Bachelor's Degree in Veterinary Sciences and Animal Husbandry or equivalent from a recognized University with registration in the Veterinary Council of India.

**Note:** Candidates not in possession of requisite educational qualification certificate or appearing in the examination/awaiting result/not in possession of certificate of registration from the Veterinary Council of India need not to apply.

6. **PHYSICAL STANDARD:**

The candidates should satisfy the minimum physical standards as under :

- (a) **For Male:**  
Height - 157.5 Cms

Chest - 77 Cms (Unexpanded)  
82 Cms (Expanded)  
Weight - Proportionate to height and age.

**Note:** Relaxable by 2 cms for Gorkhas, Garwalis, Kumaonis, Dogras, Marathas and by 03 cms in respect of Adivasis.

**(b) For Female:**

Height - 142 Cms  
Chest - Not applicable  
Weight - Proportionate to height and age.

CP III ISHARA PLATES	- In right handed person, the Right eye is better eye and vice versa. - Binocular vision is required.

The candidates must not have knock knee, flat foot, varicose veins, squint in eyes and they should possess high colour vision. The candidates must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of their duties.

**Note:-** Candidates having permanent tattoo on any part of the body will be debarred from the recruitment in CAPFs.

**8. FEE PAYABLE & MODE OF PAYMENT**

(a) The General/OBC category candidates will have to pay examination fee Rs.400/- (Rupees four hundred only). SC/ST, Ex-serviceman and female candidates are not required to submit examination fee.

(b) The candidates should pay the fee through Bank Draft/Postal Order in favour of "Commandant 25 Bn BSF", payable at SBI Najafgarh, A.D.B., Branch Code No.1419 for Rs.400/- as examination fee.
