

NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 27th May, 2011

G.S.R. 169.— In exercise of the powers conferred by clauses (b) and (c) of sub-section (2) of Section 141 of the Border Security Force Act, 1968 (47 of 1968), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules to amend the Border Security Force, Constable (Tradesman), Group 'C' Posts, Recruitment Rules, namely: -

1. (1) These rules may be called the Border Security Force, Constable (Tradesman), Group 'C' Posts, Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2011.

(2) They shall come into Force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Schedule to the Border Security Force, Constable (Tradesman), Group 'C' Posts, Recruitment Rules, 2010, against the posts of Constable(Tradesmen),—

(i) in column (8), for the entries, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“(a) Matriculation or equivalent from a recognised University or Board with—

(i) two years work experience in respective trades; or

(ii) one year certificate course from Industrial Training Institute of Vocational Institute with at least one year experience in the trade; or

(iii) two years Diploma from Industrial Training Institute in the trade or similar trade.

(b) Must qualify trade test.

Note : Multi-skilled candidates will be given preference.

Medical Standard for Men and Women:

(i) Vision. —Minimum distant vision should be 6/6 and 6/9 of both eyes without correction (i.e. without wearing glasses).

(ii) Must pass high grade colour vision test. Must not have knock-knees, flat feet or squint in eyes. Must not have any defect or deformity which likely to interfere with the efficient performance of the duties.

(iii) Must qualify the physical efficiency test and Medical examination.”;

(ii) in column (11), for the entries, the following shall be substituted, namely:—

“100% by direct recruitment

Note : The number of vacancies for induction of female candidates in the rank of Constable (Tradesman) will be calculated on year to year basis by the Director General Border Security Force on functional requirement basis.”
