

NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 5th July, 2002

G. S. R. 265.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Border Security Force Engineering Cell Group 'C' (Non Gazetted) post recruitment Rules, 1978, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the Group 'C' posts of Draftsman grade-I, Draftsman grade-II, Draftsman grade-III and Ferro Printer (Non-combatised) in the Directorate General, Border Security Force Headquarters, namely :—

1. Short, title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Border Security Force Headquarters, Engineering Cell, Group 'C' (Non combatised) posts recruitment Rules, 2002.

2. They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of post, classification and scale of pay.—The number of the said posts, their classification and scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and qualifications etc.—The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in Column (5) to (14) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification.—No person,—

(a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts :

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied, that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall effect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Ex-servicemen and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
