NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 20th May, 2009

G.S.R. 346(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by clauses (b) and (c) of sub-section (2) of section 141 of the Border Security Force Act, 1968 (47 of 1968), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules, further to amend the Border Security Force (General Duty Officers) Recruitment Rules, 2001, namely: -

1. (1) These rules may be called the Border Security Force (General Duty Officers) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2009.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. In the Schedule to the Border Security Force (General Duty Officers) Recruitment Rules, 2001, against serial number 2 relating to the post of Additional Director General, -
 - (a) under column 2, for the existing entries, the following entries shall be substituted, namely :-

****04(Four) (2009)**
*** Subject to variation dependent upon workload.***
 - (b) under column 4, for the existing entries, the following entries shall be substituted, namely :-

"Rs. 37400-67000 + Grade pay Rs.12000.";
 - (c) under column 5, for the existing entries, the following entries shall be substituted, namely :-

"Selection.";
 - (d) under column 11, for the existing entries, the following entries shall be substituted, namely :-

"33-1/3% By promotion of cadre Officers.
66-2/3% By deputation of Indian Police Service Officers.";
 - (e) under column 12, before the existing entries, the following entries shall be inserted, namely:-

"By Promotion

 - (i) **From amongst Inspectors General of Border Security Force who have rendered minimum thirty years of group 'A' service including three years as Inspector General.**
 - (ii) **Medical Category SHAPE-I**

- (f) under column 13, for the existing entries, the following entries shall be substituted, namely :-

“Group ‘A’ Departmental Promotion Committee: The Promotion Committee shall consist of the following members namely:-
